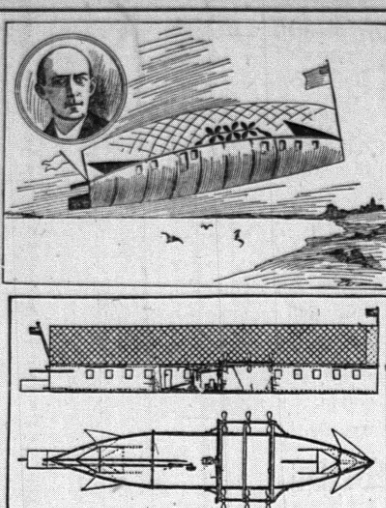


DEATH OF CHICAGO INVENTOR STOPS BUILDING OF AIRSHIP
