Social Problems In Japan.

While the world in general notes with growing admiration the political and martial achievements of the Japs, wide awake students of events who have first hand knowledge of the social conditions are looking at the problems which lie beneath the surface in the nikudo's realm.

Labor forces (comparatively speaking) are being accumulated at one end of the social scale, while degraded poverty is appearing at the other, and as yet no effective means have been devised either to alleviate or prevent it.

Efficiency of Torpedo Boats.

Japanese naval authorities have ordered twenty five additional torpedo boat destroyers for the fleet. Having had the latest experience, and a valuable one, too, with all manner of auxiliary vessels, the Japs ought to know what they are doing.

France leads all other nations in the number of torpedoes owned. She has 286 torpedo boats and destroyers. Her torpedos boats proper outnumber those of Germany, Great Britain and the United States combined.

A remarkable connection between the autumn rainfall and the wheat yield has been noted by the British meteorological council. "With certain exceptions," says a recent report by the secretary, "every inch of autumn rainfall involves a diminution of the yield of wheat for the following year by a bushel and a quarter per acre."
