## MICHIGAN BANK CLOSES DOOR

**Failure of Owosso Institution Due to Loan to Carriage Company.**  
**SYMPATHY FROM DEPOSITORS**

Citizens, Whose Money is Tied Up, Express Faith in the President. Evidence of His Honesty Being of Unusual Character.

Owosso, Mich., dispatch: An evidence of the great faith held in officials of the defunct Stewart bank of this city, which closed its doors Saturday, the Chamber of Commerce expressed the assurance that the institution will pay in full.

More conservative estimates place the rate of settlement at about 100 per cent. The Owosso Carriage Company, which is the direct cause of the downfall of the bank, has had a checkered career, having made an assignment to Stewart several years ago, and it has never proved a paying investment.

**Cause of Failure.**  
 The American Audit company of New York, which recently completed an audit of the bank's books, found it indebted to the bank to the amount of \$28,000 past due and a large amount, probably between \$5,000 and \$10,000, due May 1. These amounts they are unable to meet.

It is expected that the assignment of the concern will be announced before many days. The following prominent business men are officials of the company:

A. M. Bently, president; Charles D. Stewart, vice president; Joseph P. Cranston, secretary; Charles Shaffer, treasurer.

**Sympathetic With President.**  
 Although the majority of the citizens are lovers by the failure, expressions of sympathy for President Stewart are heard on almost every side. His long career has commanded confidence in his honesty. His desire to turn over every available dollar to the depositors, including heavy life insurance, has done much to lessen criticism of and stamp him a man who fought an honest but losing fight.

His course in closing the bank as he did has won him admiration from all. All money of the bank has been removed to Detroit pending an investigation. Mr. Stewart is at his home completely prostrated, and fears are expressed for his recovery.

## DAMAGE TO FRUIT IN INDIANA

**Cold Wave and Heaviest Snow of the Year Reported at Jeffersonville.**  
 Indianapolis, Ind., dispatch: Disasters on all parts of Indiana report snow storms and a fall in temperature. In the northern portion it is believed that early frost has been serious damage to fruit. Throughout the central and southern portions, however, fruit has escaped injury, according to the belief of growers.

Another drop of the mercury may prove very damaging to the crop. The Louisville reports the heaviest snowfall of the year.

The temperature throughout the state varies between 28 and 31 degrees above zero.

**Dea Motter, Iowa, April 17.** - Frost severely damaged hundreds of acres of oats and small fruit in Jefferson county. The loss will be heavy.

**Bay, N. Y., April 17.** - The blizzard of snow and ice which struck this region created much anxiety regarding fruit and early vegetables. The indications are that no material damage has been done.

**Inventor of Philanthropist's Estate Shows He was a Multimillionaire.**  
 Muskegon, Mich., dispatch: By the inventory filed in the probate court the estate of Charles H. Hackley, a deceased philanthropist of this city, is valued at over \$250,000 in Michigan alone. The inventory includes no real estate outside Michigan. Since a large share of the property is situated in northern lumber regions the entire estate will amount approximately to \$600,000.

Mattoon, Ill., dispatch: Thomas Beveridge, nephew of United States Senator Beveridge of Indiana, seriously stabbed James Datedwood. The fight followed a quarrel in a saloon. Datedwood assaulted Beveridge, who drew a knife and slashed him in the face and side. While attempting to escape arrest Beveridge was shot twice by an officer. Both injured men are in the hospital, but will recover. Warrants have been issued for their arrest.

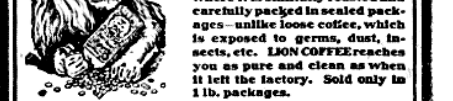
