A Weak Point in Our Navy.

Admiral Lee thinks the present time, when there is no fighting in prospect for years to come, a fitting one to openly discuss a vital point in our naval armament which is so weak that, to use the admiral's own language, "the navy would find itself unable to win battles." It is better to learn that truth now than to have it disclosed by further disaster in the event of war. The weakness consists of a woeful lack of engineering skill on the part of the men who are to operate our modern complicated ships. Naval engineering is in the highest degree a technical science and one not to be mastered by every officer who may have general capacity for the service.

A bill to equip every naval officer with engineering experience has been on the books for three years, but for a variety of reasons little has been done to carry out its provisions. Chief among the drawbacks to the system adopted by the bill referred to is the dislike of the average naval officer for the duties of the engine room. Furthermore, many an officer who is capable in every other branch has no aptitude for mechanical science.

Our navy is necessarily a great burden financially, and if it is to be maintained should always be ready for war. In 1898 we were plunged into a conflict on short notice. Russia was taken by surprise in 1904, and the want of naval mechanics and engineers is believed to have caused the delay in the sailing of the Baltic fleet. Admiral Rae is at the head of the engineering department of the navy and speaks in plain language, with full knowledge of his subject. He says that young officers who would not be trusted alone in charge of the deck of a warship have been placed aboard at the head of the engine room. In one notable instance of recent date this state of things led to a disaster more costly in money and lives than many a stirring naval battle. The scarcity of officers caused by the large number of ships in commission has in measure prevented the training of the younger men in engineering duties. It is proposed by Admiral Rae that this training be no longer neglected for any cause and that instruction in the engine room be given under the supervision of specialists detailed for the duty. Even this plan would require years to bring out a supply of officers competent to handle a ship under all circumstances. And as fast as the warships multiply in number more competent engineer officers will be needed.

Russian Mob Law.

When the mob takes the field in Russia it makes no distinction between liberty and license. The people do not band together to shout and let off steam, as they do in England, for instance, and subsist after an assembly of officials has been hooted into the street, a few windows broken and some skulls cracked. The Russians are moved with serious wrath and, before moving in taking law into their own hands, become intoxicated with the new power suddenly revealed to them. A few weeks or months should end the excesses in Russia and peace and order succeed to chaos. The new order of government may remain imperial or become republican, the result may hang together or split up into several states, but whatever the political outcome shall be the future of Russia will be more glorious than the past. The people are aroused as they never have been before. New inspirations and aspirations will be born in these heated hours of trial, and the pent up energies of a vast and mighty people will become creative and productive and add to the moral and material resources of civilization.

One outcome of the presidential campaign in Cuba will be the formation of a plan to bring about annexation to the United States. The officials firmly seated in the Cuban government will oppose annexation, and this country has yet to make up her mind as to the desirability of such a conclusion to her peculiar relations with that island.
