Value of Some Old Coins

Flying eagle cents of 1857 and 1858 are worth 1 to 2 cents; half dimes of 1852 and 1853 bring 5 to 10 cents; 3-cent pieces of 1851 and 1852 bring 5 to 25 cents; 5-cent pieces of 1867, if silver, from 2 to 10 cents; if nickel, 5 to 25 cents; 2-cent piece of 1857 is worth from 2 to 10 cents; an 1855 dime, 10 to 15 cents; large copper cents of 1845 and 1848, from 1 to 15 cents.

Term "O. K." First Used in Tennessee Court Records

The first known use of the term O. K. appears in the court records of Sumner county, Tennessee, October 8, 1793. On that date Andrew Jackson "proved a bill of sale from Hugh McCarty to Gaspar Mankler for a negro man, which was O. K. James Parton, in his biography of Jackson, suggests that what appeared to be O. K. in the record may really have been a poorly penned O. H., which was the abbreviation for "Ordered Recorded."

Wonders in Wales
