Worship of Former Pastor of Fairfield Church Praised by His Friends

Another brief chapter in the history of Fairfield Lutheran church recently celebrated its 70th anniversary. It is worth submitting for the benefit of the church's former pastor, the record of the pastorate of Rev. Henry Heise of Waukegan, which extended over a period of 15 years at Fairfield.

During those 15 years, through Rev. Heise's leadership, the congregation increased both spiritually and numerically. On the occasion of the 70th anniversary of the church, the services were completely renovated, the church furniture was added, and the plant and electric lights were replaced. The Christian Day school building was repaired and likewise equipped with new desks and benches. The building was greatly improved by the addition of a study and a heating unit. A spacious hall for activities, including heating, lights, was constructed and used for the entertainment of young and old for the congregation of their friends. Fairfield congregation could well be proud of its building and its facilities.

The greatest interest of Rev. Heise's pastorate was felt in his spiritual influence. An able preacher, he was a true leader.

His own Master's last words: "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature," he has been impressing upon his people the message of the church's true work in the world.
