

**Cobblers Had Union in 1648**  
The labor union apparently had its counterpart back in the middle of the seventeenth century. In 1648 records show a "Company of Shoemakers" known as the Boston Guild was organized under a charter granted by the Massachusetts Bay Colony. A copy of the charter, appearing in a colony record, shows that it was not an attempt for a closed shop but to protect the public against inferior work and the industry against unfair competition.
