## DO YOU KNOW ILLINOIS?

The secretary of state of Illinois is the state librarian ex-officio. The state library and archives division under his jurisdiction contains much information concerning your state.

Q. How may a state officer be impeached? A. The house of representatives has the sole power of impeachment.

Q. What is the extent of punishment which may be meted out to an impeached state officer? A. It can extend only as far as removal from office and disqualification to hold any office of trust or profit under the government of the state.

Q. Should a governor be tried by the senate would the lieutenant governor, as president of that body, preside over the trial? A. In the case of a trial of the governor...

Q. What is the constitutional provision concerning the incurring of a state debt? A. Any proposal to incur a state debt in excess of \$250,000 must be approved by the voters of the state.

Q. What is the requirement of the carrying of a constitutional amendment at an election? A. It must have been approved by a majority of those voting at such an election, not merely by a majority of those voting on the amendment itself.

Q. What is the alien population of Illinois? A. 254,160, or 2.4 per cent (1930 census).

Q. What is the total native white population of Illinois? A. 6,645,297, or 75.1 per cent (1930 census).

Q. What was the percentage of increase in Illinois urban population between 1920 and 1930? A. 25 per cent.

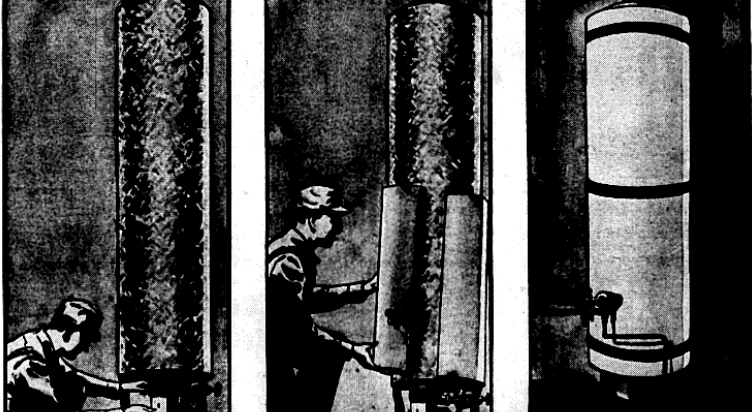
