Two Women Lose Lives After Auto Accidents Here Injuries Received on Route 19 a Month Ago Bring Death to One

Two women are dead as a result of automobile accidents, which occurred Friday night at the intersection of routes 19 and 14, southwest of Barrington, and the other on September 15 on the Northwest highway at Elgin, west of town.

Her death came as a surprise as she was reported improving. Although she received eight fractured ribs, a broken nose and fractured frontal skull bones, she had made rapid strides toward recovery and was considered out of danger.
