



## How to stream movies and audiobooks on a computer with Hoopla

### Step #1: Access the library's streaming video and audio catalog

- Go to [www.balibrary.org](http://www.balibrary.org)
- Click on **film & tv** at the top of the screen.
- Click on **Hoopla**.

Hoopla is the library's catalog of streaming movies, television, and audiobooks. You can check out 8 items every month from this catalog! Hoopla supports Internet Explorer 8 or above, Google Chrome, Firefox 8 or above, and Safari.

### Step #2: Create an account with Hoopla

- Click on **Sign up today** at the bottom left of the screen.
- Agree to the terms and conditions of use.
- Enter your e-mail address and create a password for your account.
- Choose Barrington Area Library and enter your library card number and PIN. Your default PIN is the last four digits of your phone number.

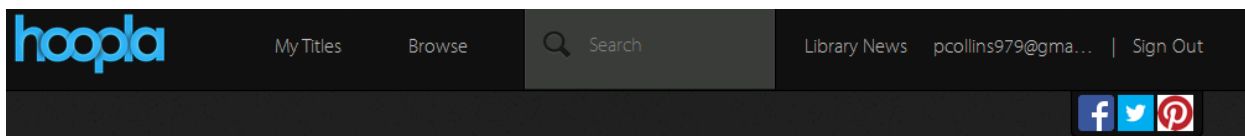

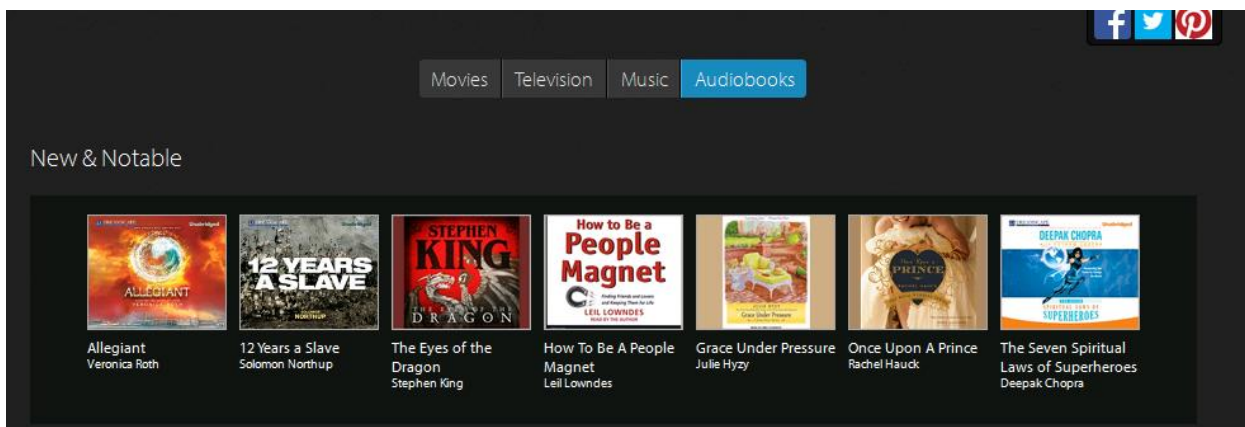
- Click **Register**.

### Step #3: Browse the collection or search for a title

- Click **Browse** at the top of the page or search for a title in the search box.



- Choose **Movies**, **Television**, or **Audiobooks** to browse titles.



### Step #4: Borrow a movie, television episode, or audiobook

- Click on a title.
- Click **Borrow**.
- If you have reached your limit for the month, click **Add as Favorite** to save it for later.
- The **Borrow** button for TV series is listed next to each episode.
- Movies and TV episodes check out for 72 hours. Audiobooks check out for 3 weeks.

### Step #5: Enjoy!

- Click **Play**.
- The first time you watch a video, you will be prompted to install the Widevine browser plugin. Follow the prompts to install this free plugin.
