



How to stream movies and audiobooks on a mobile device with Hoopla

Step #1: Install the Hoopla app

- Go to the App Store or Google Play Store and search for **Hoopla**.



- Download and open the Hoopla Digital app.

Hoopla is the library's catalog of streaming movies and audiobooks. You can check out 8 items every month from this catalog! Hoopla supports iPhones and iPads running iOS6 or above, iPod Touch 4th generation or above, and Android devices running Android 4.0 (Ice Cream Sandwich) or above.

Step #2: Create an account with Hoopla

- Touch **Sign Up** at the top left of the screen.
- Agree to the terms and conditions of use.
- Choose Barrington Area Library and enter your library card number or PIN. Your default PIN is the last four digits of your phone number.
- Enter your email address and create a password for your account.

Step #3: Browse the collection or search for a title

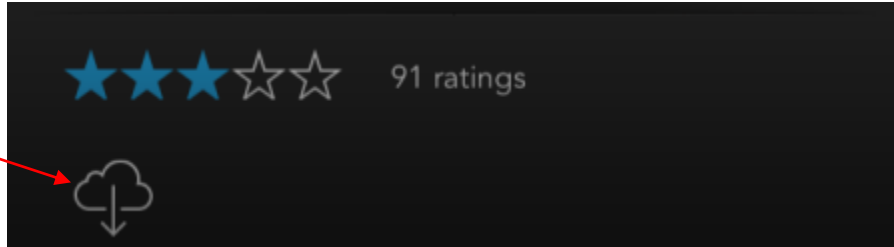
- Choose **Movies**, **Television**, or **Audiobooks** to browse titles, or use the search box to look for something specific.

Step #4: Borrow a movie, television episode, or audiobook

- Touch a title.
- Touch **Borrow**.
- If you have reached your limit for the month, touch the heart icon to save it for later.
- To borrow a TV episode, touch the title of the episode and then touch **Borrow**.
- Movies and TV episodes check out for 72 hours. Audiobooks check out for 3 weeks.

Step #5: Enjoy!

- Touch the menu icon at the top left of the screen and then touch **Borrowed**.
- Touch the item you wish to watch or listen to.
- Touch the play icon on the item to begin playback.
- To download for offline playback, touch the cloud icon.
