ORDER AS TO THE INCORPORATION OF
THE "VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON"

On this 2nd day of November, 1959, the canvass of the returns of the special election called on the question of the incorporation of a village under the general law to be known as the VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON in the above entitled cause coming before the undersigned Judge of the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, the undersigned Judge FINDS:

1. That upon the entry of an order by the undersigned Judge of the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, on October 15, 1959, the question of the incorporation of a village under the general law to be known as the "VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON" was submitted to the electors residing in the territory proposed to be incorporated as said village at a special election duly held on October 31, 1959; that proper notice of said election was given not less than fifteen (15) nor more than thirty (30) days prior to the date thereof by posting notices on October 15, 1959 in five prominent and easily visible public places located in the territory proposed to be incorporated as provided by law; no newspaper being printed or published within said territory, and by publishing a notice in the Waukegan News-Sun on October 16, 1959 said newspaper having a general circulation

within said territory; and that said territory is contiguous territory, does not exceed two square miles, is not included within the corporate limits of any municipality and no part of said territory lay within one mile of the boundary line of any existing municipality, at the time of the filing of the petition for incorporation.

2. That properly executed affidavits of the posting and of the publishing of the aforesaid notice of election have been heretofore filed herein.

3. That the ballot used at said election is as follows:

OFFICIAL BALLOT

(INSTRUCTION TO VOTERS: Place a cross (X) in the space to the right of the word indicating the way you desire to vote.)

Shall the territory described as follows: All those parts of Sections 3, 10, 11, 14, 15 and 16 in Township 43 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Lake County, Illinois, bounded by a line described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 3; thence East along the North line of Section 3 to the East line of Section 3; thence South along said East line of Section 3 to the center line of Roberts Road; thence Northwesterly and Westerly along said center line of Roberts Road to the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 3; thence South along the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 3 and the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 10 to the North line of the South half of the South half of Section 10; thence East along the North line of the South half of the South half of Section 10 and along the North line of the South half of the South half of Section 11 to the West line of the right of way of State Route 59; thence South along said West line of the right of way of State Route 59 to the North line of Miller Road; thence Westerly along the North line of Miller Road to its intersection with the Northwardly prolongation of the West line of Section 14; thence Southwardly along the Northwardly prolongation of the West line of Section 14 and the West line of Section 14 to its intersection with a line located 1/2 mile South of and parallel with the North line of Section 14; thence East along said line located 1/2 mile South of and parallel with the North line of Section 14 to a point 300 feet East of the West line of Section 14; thence South along a line parallel to and 300 feet East of the West line of Section 14 to the Northerly line of the right of way of Barrington Road; thence Northwesterly and Westerly along said Northerly line of the right of way of Barrington Road to the North line of the South half of Section 15; thence West along the North line of the South half of Section 15 and the North line of the South half of Section 16 to a point 5281 feet East of the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 17, Township 43 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian; thence North along a line parallel to and 5281 feet East of said West line of the East half of the East half of Section 17, Township 43 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian to the North line of Section 16; thence East along said North line of Section 16 to the East line of Section 16; thence South along said East line of Section 16 to the center line of Kelsey Road; thence Northeasterly and Easterly along said center line of Kelsey Road to its intersection with the East line of the West half of Section 10; thence North along said East line of the West half of Section 10 to the North line of the South half of Section 10; thence West along said North line of the South half of Section 10 to the East line of the West half of the West half of Section 10; thence North along the East line of the West half of the West half of Section 10 and the East line of the West half of the West half of Section 3 to the point of beginning in the Town of Cuba, Lake County, Illinois, be incorporated as a Village under the general law? 4. That said election was duly held as provided by law.

5. That the judges of said election, as provided by law, did return to the undersigned Judge of the County Court the ballots, poll records and tally sheets, together with certificate showing the results of said election.

6. That the undersigned Judge of the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, with the assistance of Richard B. Seyfarth and Carlton A. Smith

being duly qualified and acting Justices of the Peace in and for Lake County, Illinois, did canvass the returns of said election as provided by law; and that the canvass of the returns of said election show that there were 68 ballots cast as follows:

YES: 62
NO: 6

Defective ballots cast 1

7. That the majority of the votes cast at said election favored incorporation as a village under the general law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that the results of said election held on October 31, 1959 as hereinabove set forth be spread and entered upon the records of the County Court of Lake County, Illinois, and that the incorporation of a village to be known as the "VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON" as proposed in the petition for incorporation heretofore filed herein on October 15, 1959 having received a majority of the votes cast at said election, the territory described as follows, to-wit:

North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Township 43 North, Illinois, bounded by a line described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 3; thence East along the North line of Section 3 to the East line of Section 3; thence South along said East line of Section 3 to the center line of Roberts Road; thence Northwesterly and Westerly along said center line of Roberts Road to the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 3; thence South along the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 3 and the West line of the South half of the South half of Section 10; thence East along the North line of the South half of the South half of Section 10 and along the North line of the South half of the South half of Section 11 to the West line of the right of way of State Route 59; thence South along said West line of the right of way of State Route 59 to the North line of Miller Road; thence Westerly along the North line of Miller Road to its intersection with the Northwardly prolongation of the West line of Section 14; thence Southwardly along the Northwardly prolongation of the West line of Section 14 and the West line of Section 14 to its intersection with a line located 1/2 mile South of and parallel with the North line of Section 14; thence East along said line located 1/2 mile South of and parallel with the North line of Section 14 to a point 300 feet East of the West line of Section 14; thence South along a line parallel to and 300 feet East of the West line of Section 14 to the Northerly line of the right of way of Barrington Road; thence Northwesterly and Westerly along said Northerly line of the right of way of Barrington Road to the North line of the South half of Section 15; thence West along the North line of the South half of Section 15 and the North line of the South half of Section 16 to a point 5281 feet East of the West line of the East half of the East half of Section 17, Township 43 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian; thence North along a line parallel to and 5281 feet East of said West line of the East half of the East half of Section 17, Township 43 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian to the North line of Section 16; thence East along said North line of Section 16 to the East line of Section 16; thence South along said East line of Section 16 to the center line of Kelsey Road; thence Northeasterly and Easterly along said center line of Kelsey Road to its intersection with the East line of the West half of Section 10; thence North along said East line of the West half of Section 10 to the North line of the South half of Section 10; thence West along said North line of the South half of Section 10 to the East line of the West half of the West half of Section 10; thence North along the East line of the West half of the West half of Section 10 to the East line of the West half of the West half of Section 10 to the point of beginning in the County of Cook, Illinois,

and the inhabitants of said territory, be and the same is hereby incorporated as a village under the general law with the name "VILLAGE OF LAKE BARRINGTON", and shall be a body politic and corporate under said name, and shall henceforth exercise all the powers conferred by law upon such bodies politic.
